

Today at 18:00, an armed group of the Taliban movement occupied the Khwahan County of Afghan Badakhshan Province without a fight, reports the Press Center of the Border Troops of the State Committee for National Security of Tajikistan.

In order to save their lives, 94 servicemen of the Afghan Armed Forces retreated, crossed the state border and entered into Tajikistan through “Shohon” area of the “Shamsiddin Shohin” border detachment.
